Lease Statistics (November 2005)

The lease transaction volume in November 2005 was 592.6 billion yen, increased by 4.0% compared with the same period of the last year, and the increase is in a row of 3 months since last September.

With respect to the type of equipment, Factory Equipment (22.5% up) has been positively increasing. Medical Equipment (14.3% up) and Transport Equipment (11.3% up) has showed double-digit increase and Commercial and Service Equipment (3.5% up) has also risen. Industrial Equipment (2.5% up) has shifted from the decline to the positive growth, although Industrial Equipment had been in decline for the last 3 months since last August. On the other hand, Telecommunication Equipment (8.1% down) and Construction Equipment (8.1% down) have changed their positive growth to the decline. Office Equipment (10.0% down) has been also receding.

The lease transaction volume from April 2005 to November is 5,947 billion yen, increased by 2.4 % over the same period of the previous year.
